Hidden Cove is an adventure that has fun for all ages. Race around the outdoor miniature racetrack in one of their exciting go-carts or try your luck at one of their miniature golf courses. If golf isn't your children's favorite sport, have them hit a few balls in the batting cages. They have 3 softball batting cages and 4 baseball batting cages. Other outdoor activities that Hidden Cove offers are their rock climbing wall and their paintball field. Hidden Cove also offers a variety of indoor activities as well. Whether you are a video game fanatic or like to miniature bowl Hidden Cove offers a variety of activities. They are also completing a new state-of-the-art SportsPlex that includes an indoor soccer arena, basketball and volleyball courts. The SportsPlex also has the ability to host pitching, indoor batting, football, dodge ball and much more.

After using all of your energy around the Park, take a breath and head to new [Perkey's Pizza](#), located in the main building of Hidden Cove. After you have filled up with pizza, head to [Perry Farm](#) for an afternoon of more outdoor and indoor activities.

Perry Farm is located just off Kennedy drive in Bourbonnais. This farm is actually a park for your child to explore and discover. They can hike the trails, play games, visit the farm animal zoo or explore the ancient Indian caves along the Kankakee River. If you are tired of being outdoors, go inside to the [Exploration Station](#), a children's museum located on the premises of Perry Farm.

The Exploration Station is a hands-on museum that gives your child the opportunity to dress and play in the Medieval Castle. There are tunnels to crawl in and explore, face paint, and lookout towers for you to climb too. You can also become a plumber, build water ways, play music on the PVC pipe organs, or discover sea shells and coral skeletons in the Water Room station. There are also Pirate Ship, Jet Plane, US Mail, Space Center, Firefighter and Tractor exhibits inside the Exploration Station.

The day is beginning to wind down but you are not yet ready to call it a day yet, so it's off to [Splash Pad](#) where your child can feed the ducks and play on some of the best outdoor playground equipment available. This park overlooks the river so the scenery is beautiful and it is a great place to see the sunset!

The sun is about to go down but your child is not tired yet, so head to one of the local hotels where there is a swimming pool for the kids and yourself to enjoy. Order dinners delivered and relax while enjoying the pool.
